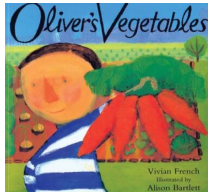
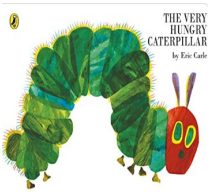
Welcome to our Spring Term Reception Class Newsletter!

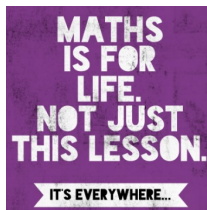


Speaking and Listening

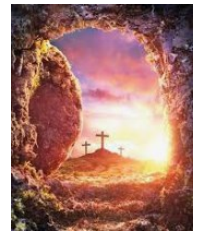


Science Learning
