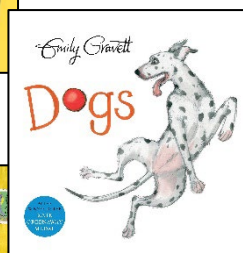
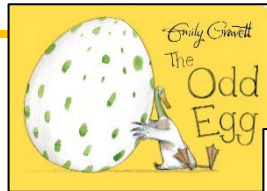
## Spring Term Newsletter

### English Learning
