Science Learning




Maths learning

English Learning

We start the half term reading, discussing and using as stimulus for writing lots of books by the author Anthony Browne. Our core texts will be 'Hide and Seek', 'Into the Woods' and 'Hansel and Gretel'.



PE

During the spring term we start to use more apparatus during PE which the children will love. There is lots of learning around balancing and moving in different ways and, later, a focus on coordination and ball skills!

Art and Design

The children will be learning about sculpture in Art. Our artist focus will be the wonderfully creative Andy Goldsworthy who we will use as inspiration for artwork using natural resources and clay.
